WEEK-END GABARES'TOUR





ROUTE

This tour is 57 kilometers long and goes from Angouleme to Cognac, with a stop in Bassac, to be completed within two days on the Charente, one of the most peaceful rivers. You are on the Gabares'route, those flatbottomed boats which used to transport local eau-de-vie, paper and varied materials required towards Rochefort's arsenal, then bring back inland fish, salt and spice.

Historical cities: Angoulême, Jarnac, Cognac, (optional visits).



SIGHTSEEING

This river is peaceful since it was unlisted from the « Navigable Waterways of France » in 1926. This tour, or at least a very close route, has twice already had the pleasure of receiving the FISA label (French Federation for Rowing Associations). in 1988 and 1998; which underlines the quality of this programand the richness to be discovered on the riverbanks. Charente is a river as peaceful as a lake and the bordering monuments fit in the surrounding greenery as if Nature itself had built them. Abbeys, mansions, Renaissance castles and natural landscapes blend in a perfect harmony..
