PICANTINS TOUR


02 & 03 june

2 days / 40 km


REQUIRED LEVEL


ROUTE

This 34km long tour will take you from the Oise River to the Aisne River and across 3 small locks: 20km on Saturday, then back on Sunday. Bike lovers may follow the tour along the bank, as long as they bring their own mountain bike.

And if you don't like rowing or cycling, you may still join the tour on a leisure boat. The Sport Nautique Compiégnois can cancel the leisure boat option if there are less than 5 persons.

SIGHTSEEING

The Picantins tour will take you across History. You may also visit the National Car and Tourism Museum in Compiègne castle, which used to be an ancient imperial and royal residence and was listed as historical Monument in 1994. Those of you who would rather wander around the city may follow the trail along the rampart and meet the Picantins ! You will discover as well as the city of Compiègne from the 18th century until 1914. Those of you who wish to extend their week end and enjoy some gastronomical tourism may bring back typical delicacies such as Maroilles cheese, champagne and salted lamb from the baie de Somme !

BOATS

Recreational four-person sculling boats



FEES

120 € : without accommodation, 3 meals included

135 € : with accommodation in the small castle (rooms for 2 to 6 persons), 1 night and 3 meals included



FOR COMPANIONS

Pleasure boat: 135 €: without accommodation, 3 meals included

150 €: with accommodation (2 to 6 persons/ bedroom), 1 night and 3 meals included

By bike: Identical fees


SEAT RENTAL

40 seats available, 15 € for the week-end



SAFETY

Supervision : 30 people

Safety boats : 3



PROVISIONAL PLANNING

Day 1: 9.30am: welcome - 10am: either the National Car and Tourism Museum or a visit in the historical city center (different from last year's) - noon: lunch - 1pm - 6pm: 20 km by boat through locks to reach Attichy (you may follow by bike or pleasure boat) - 6pm-6.30pm: drinks - 16.30pm: return to Compiègne by bus - 8pm: dinner and dancing.

Day 2: 7am: breakfast - 7.30am: bus to reach Attichy - 9am -1.30pm: 20 km rowing through locks to reach Compiègne (you may follow by bike or pleasure boat) - 2pm: lunch - 3.30pm: either 10km rowing or ergo challenge.
