

TOUR REIMS-CHAMPAGNE





ROUTE

This tour will take you between town and countryside, to the discovery of Champagne's capital on Sunday morning. The route follows the green pathway of Reims city and allows you to see the famous places of the « Cité des Sacres »: Notre-Dame cathedral and Saint Remi basilica.

You will alternate between natural landscapes of fields and woods and city ones with an arrival at Courcy, where many violent fights took place during the Great War. You will then head back to the club where a warm welcome awaits you.

Companions may follow the tour by bike or else chose to spend the morning discovering the local UNESCO heritage sites.


SIGHTSEEING

On Saturday afternoon, after a coffee you will visit the local vineyards, the vineyard museum, and a wine cellar where you may taste the local elixir (drink responsibly!) The first day will end on a festive dinner and dancing.

On Sunday afternoon, after the tour and a lunch at the club, we will accompany the bravest for a visit of Reims, to see its famous Art Deco facades and its cathedral. Other visit may be on the menu depending on your wishes: Saint Rémi museum, Tau Palace, the «Musée de la Reddition» where was signed the German surrender on May the 7th, 1945...

There are other places to visit around Reims, numerous memories related to the Great War, such as the « Fort de la Pompelle » museum, the « Chemin des Dames »...
