COLORFUL MARNE



06 october

1 day / 40 km



REQUIRED LEVEL



ROUTE

The tour will take place on a portion of the Marne River which is almost entirely inaccessible to commercial boats, and you will wander along its twists and turns and discover the calm and quiet of this typical autumn countryside. Along the way you will discover the Quincangrogne mill, the Dhuiz, which provides the capital with drinkable water and can easily be spotted thanks to a stone sculpture site. Then you will discover Chalifert and its lock at starboard - though you won't cross it during this tour - and finally a 11 km long peninsula. Among other things, you may see: the pontoon used for the unloading of containers, and the villages of Annet-sur-Marne and Précý (of which the French singer Yves Duteil is mayor) and where the famous French singer Barbara lived for 24 years, then, when you reach the middle of the tour (18 km), you will see Trilbardou Dam (impassable) then land on the site of the factory (property of the city of Paris) in charge of bringing water up from the Marne to the Ourq.

SIGHTSEEING

You will discover unexpected sites all along the way, filled with a rich fauna (over 71 different species of birds). You will navigate inside a privileged site east of the greater Paris. Marne is the longest river in France (525 km long). The tour is 40 km long (two way trip) in a green environment filled with islets. The companions will have the possibility to follow on bike from Chalifert to Trilbardou. You will have a guided tour of the 1865 old factory which is still active.
