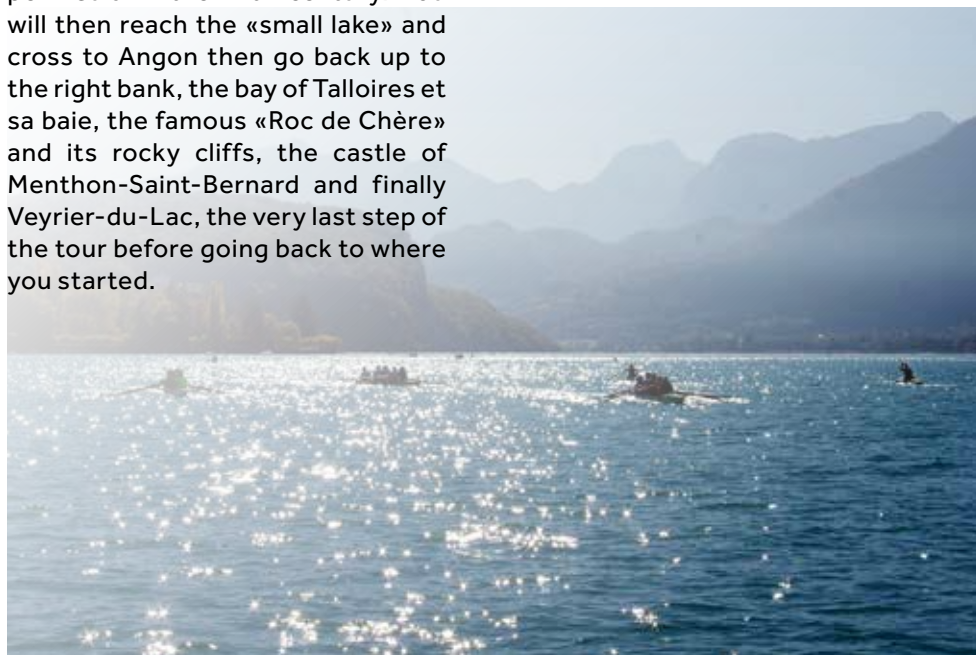


ROUTE

The tour will take you around Annecy Lake, departing from Annecy-le-Vieux rowing club. You will then head towards Annecy, along the gardens of the Imperial palace, Paquier promenade, the swan island and the pont des Amours. After Europe garden you will enjoy the old city and the castle, then go along the left bank of the lake, the mountains of Semnoz, Sévrier, Saint-Jorioz, than Duingt castle which was built on its peninsula in the 11th century. You will then reach the «small lake» and cross to Angon then go back up to the right bank, the bay of Talloires et sa baie, the famous «Roc de Chère» and its rocky cliffs, the castle of Menthon-Saint-Bernard and finally Veyrier-du-Lac, the very last step of the tour before going back to where you started.

SIGHTSEEING

This lake, one of the purest of Europe, is surrounded by the Aravis Mountains, whose highest peak, the Tournette, is 2 352 m high, and by the Bauges Mountains. In the fall, trees take on the most beautiful colors. Besides these natural attractions, sightseeing includes many monuments along the way: Annecy castles, from Duingt and Menthon, as well as typical villas and palaces.
