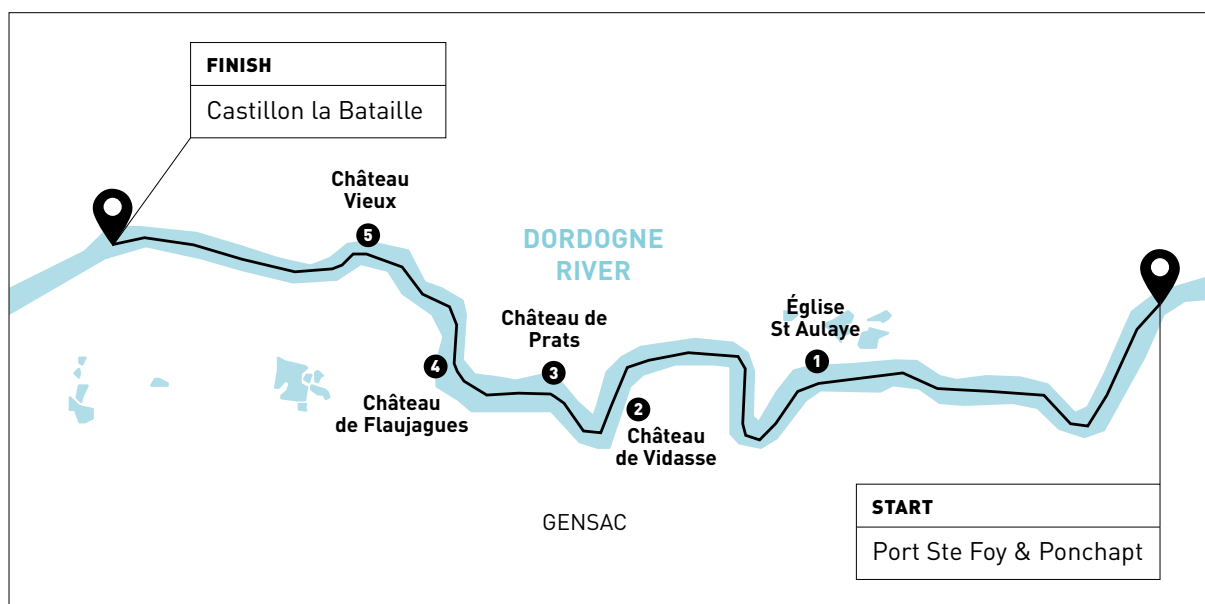

The Dordogne river was once called «Du Unna» by the Celtic people, meaning fast water. However, the proposed tour peacefully meanders between the AOC (Controlled Designation of Origin granted to agricultural products) of Sainte-Foy and the AOC of Côtes de Castillon. You will admire the winemaking châteaux with their aligned «règes» and the beautiful houses from the 18th century made of sand-colour limestone. Take some time to go and visit Saint-Emilion or Sainte-Foy-la-Grande and Castillon-la-Bataille, to complete your weekend. A guaranteed immersion in the heart of the Middle Age!
