
# MIMOSAS TOURS





## ROUTE

On Saturday morning, you will make a head to head start under the D37 bridge, then wander on the blue waters of Saint-Cassien's lake. You will then go straight up north passing the buoy and aim at the southern buoy before going back to the club. On Sunday morning you're off again for a 15 kilometers long guided tour with a group composed of five boats, to visit hidden creeks inaccessible by foot. Wild landscape guaranteed! Beside rowers, around 150 nesting bird species were identified on the site.

## SIGHTSEEING

First, you should know that anywhere but in Saint-Cassien it is still winter this time of year. This would be your very first opportunity to row under a bright sunshine. Each tour comes with a typical Provencal meal which will help you regain your strength. You can also choose to visit a blooming forest of mimosas which scents and fragrances will intoxicate you. Welcome in The Fayence area and its perched villages, the sea is not very far since Saint-Raphaël and Cannes are only a few cable lengths away. You can therefore finish your stay enjoying the Cote d'Azur while rowing along Saint-Cassien.
