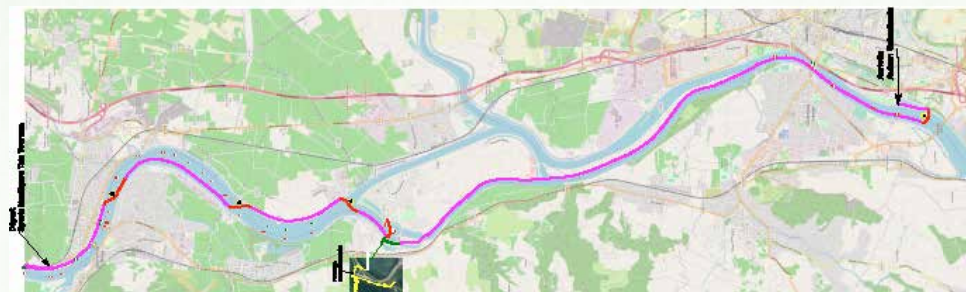
ROUTE

You will embark on the Rhône, at the foot of Hermitage and St Joseph vineyards, near the famous rock where St Louis supposedly stood in 1248, called the "Table du Roy". Downstream the Comte de Tournon castle will lead you to the heart of the cities of Tain l'Hermitage and Tournon sur Rhône and under one of the first French suspension bridge. The route will then head towards Glun rock when the Rhône river enlarges and where you will reach the old river and its arms by passing by Chateaubourg castle. One of these arms will offer an open view on the Saint Apollinaire cathedral and Crussol castle. You will arrive in the Port de l'Épervière where you will share a convivial barbecue.





SIGHTSEEING


The Rhône river regained its wildlife, especially along its arms where you may encounter many birds such as grey herons, swans, mallards, white egrets and cormorants. Most of the monuments you will see on the banks were built with granite from Ardèche. The route will offer an open point of view on the Vercors and Ardèche mounts. You will also enjoy the rich gastronomy through the tasting of great wines and typical delicacies: goat cheese, chocolate, and local brioches ("St Genis" and "Pognes").
