✓ PROVISIONAL PLANNING

Day 1 : You will start at 9.30am from Pointe Fort nautical base towards « petite Martinique » hamlet, rowing along a protected mangrove and admire its ecosystem. First break takes place on the hamlet where you can take amazing pictures and taste some local delicacies. You will then resume your adventure throughout the bay rowing along the "water hamlet", the "rat hamlet" and its reefs. You will then visit the "chancel hamlet" and its iguana reservation, where you will have lunch and enjoy the beautiful turquoise waters and white seabed. You will start again around 3pm and head towards the coasts of the town of François, near the bivouac area, where you will settle for two nights. The evenings will be spent around the fire enjoying local food and festivities.

Day 2 : After taking a local breakfast you will embark towards the town of Vauclin where you will pass several reefs and white seabed and reach the surprising emerald-colored creek named "pig hole". You will then walk a bit towards Vauclin peninsula when you may enjoy an amazing view of the Atlantic coast before going back to share lunch and then enjoy the beach before heading back at the bivouac site by 4pm.

Day 3 : Breakfast and packing before departure for the visit of François hamlets, the famous "Josephine" bathtub and Thierry hamlet underwater path. You will then go back to Robert for lunch and enjoy bathing time in the crystal waters of "Madam" hamlet. You will then leave at 4pm and head back to the nautical base.
