

# **CROSSING ANTIOCHE**





## ROUTE

This 60km long tour is intended for experienced sea rowers in good physical condition. You will discover Antioche strait and its rich natural and historical heritage. You will navigate on a busy bay where you will encounter regatta, oyster farms, ferries across islands and many Vauban fortification along the way. You will go from the Minimes harbor (1st sailing harbor on the Atlantic coast), then along the coasts where you will gaze upon many fortifications before reaching the Oleron island.



# **SIGHTSEEING**

This tour is composed of 3 parts and lasts two days, during which you will discover a landscape called the Estran, between land and sea and filled with oysters and mussels' farms. Une zone qu'enjambent les carrelets, ces cabanes de pêcheurs plantées sur l'eau au bout d'une longue passerelle en bois. Antioche strait is located between La Rochelle. Ré island and Oléron island, thus mixing several landscapes. You will navigate from a century old commercial city filled with History, towards Aix island, last place Napoléon stopped before his exile in Sainte-Hélène. You will then head towards Boyard Fort before reaching the shiny Oléron, famous holiday destination thanks to its many beaches, oyster farms, salt marshes and fortifications.

During the crossing you will enjoy the natural and architectural richness which makes the international fame of La Rochelle and its surroundings.
