ROUTE

An easy tour in a surprisingly well preserved forest landscape of Île-de-France. You will discover the very peculiar stories of houses and villages along the river (Samois-sur-Seine, Thomery, Champagne, Saint-Mammès, Moret-sur-Loing...) and the famous local rich mansions from the 19th century, called « affolantes ». You will spend your Saturday evening at the local Django Reinhart Festival. Then start over upriver on Sunday morning, cross the board gauge lock of Champagnesur-Seine, crossing St-Mammès, the bargemen city, till you land near Moret-sur-Loing for a picnic. You may even be sketched by an impressionist...! After a well-deserved two hours break you will go down the Seine river and reach Hericy (where you started) around 4.30pm.











SIGHTSEEING

On a beautiful basin in en Île-de-France, you will enjoy an easy waterfront boarding and landing, the friendly atmosphere and relaxing music announcing incoming holidays... What better way to end the season that a nice and quiet stroll with friends, a great mix of sport, culture and friendship which may be concluded with a few days hiking throughout the Fontainebleau forest. Fontainebleau is the 16th century hunting castle which was shaped by many French Kings from François I to Napoleon III ... Fontainebleau is famous of course for its forest with its great variety of trees, its peculiarly shaped sandstone rocks - still as our Gallic ancestors knew them, the French Kings games hunting, the 19th century quarry corks, the painters from the Barbizon school, and now you... Let's not forget the village of Thomery along the Seine, former vineyard of white grapes of «Chasselas» variety which provided the great Parisian restaurants from October to December and even May, thanks to specialized preservation techniques. Do not miss this exceptional tour in Île-de-France.
