ROUTE

We will take you to the heart of remarkable Mediterranean vistas in the Parc Naturel Regional de la Narbonaise, to the source of the Canal du Midi (UNESCO World Heritage), from Port la Nouvelle to the Gruissan saline by sea, or the canal itself, depending on the weather. This itinerary is part of the "Cultura Via Odyssea" European label which aims at promoting the traditional way of life and landscapes typical of Mediterranean port cities, alongside the protection of the local heritage and biodiversity. It will speak to those sensitive to the purity of natural wildlands and the richness of Mediterranean culture.


SIGHTSEEING


The tour takes place in the antic gulf whose natural lagoon was with Narbonne's harbor the very first Roman provinces. Many animations are awaiting you, among which a gastronomical race between the Palme and the Gruissan salines, as well as food-tastings and musical events, all in a typical and festive atmosphere. The antique gulf, where the trek takes place, is the home of the Mondial du Vent, and should prove a paradise for nautical enthusiasts, including surfers, paddlers and wind-yachters. The vineyards, salines, and fishermen villages are as many gastronomical halts for the food-enthusiasts.
