ROUTE

The Moissac Rowing club will be delighted to have you discover the beautiful lake and enjoy a two days trip and a 48 km tour between Tarn and Garonne rivers. You will board on Saturday morning at the club, then head towards Malause. You will go under Napoléon Bridge and enjoy a quiet and green route in the company of many birds: herons, cormorants...to the Ile aux Oiseaux nature reserve on the Plan d'Eaux in Saint-Nicolas. After enjoying a tasteful meal you will row on the Garonne river to the bridge in Malause where we will turn around to get back to the club before the afternoon ends. Then, in order to celebrate the end of this first day, you will enjoy a festive evening then head towards your accommodation which is located near Moissac and its famous listed cloister. On the next day you will head towards the Pont canal and Sainte-Livrade castle for a 16 km long delightful trip.




SIGHTSEEING


Moissac, is filled with a thousand years of History. The roman cloister and tympanum of its abbey are classified as world heritage by the UNESCO. You will have the opportunity to taste one of the Moissac's finest specialties : Chasselas grape, the first fruit to gain AOC, and PHILIBON melons which ripened on the hills, which you will relish on for two days !!!
