ROUTE

The tour will first lead you eastward to Almanare beach, famous spot for kitesurf and windsurf competitions. On Giens' peninsula you may admire a rare geographical phenomenon called double tombolo, then follow the peninsula up to Ile Longue and the Fourmigues' wild islets. Afterwards you will leave them at starboard and for a 5 kilometers' long crossing to Bau Rouge's cliffs. You may then follow the coast to go back where you started and discover the beautifully preserved Carqueiranne coastline. This tour makes you wander throughout a «NATURA 2000 » classified area.

SIGHTSEEING

Carqueiranne is a sea resort located between the villages of Hyères and Le Pradet, and the Mont des Oiseaux mountain and the Colle Noire hill. It offers a variety of landscapes, between sandy beaches of Almanarre, the Fourniques islets, and the rocky shore of Bau Rouge. We are in deep contact with nature so as to respect a well preserved coastline with its numerous conservation areas. Carqueiranne enjoys a microclimate that benefits the cultivation of flowers, especially the tulip, which has become the city's emblem.
