ROUTE

Thanks to this tour you will discover Metz city and its surroundings. Boats launching will take place just a few hundred meters away from the « Société des Régates Messines », on the Jouy canal. This canal has not been in use for commerce since 1982 and is now a « green corridor » filled with a great variety of wild landscapes, mixing small hidden spaces and remarkable points of view along Moselle banks, St Quentin Mount and urbanized areas. You will reach the Moselle at Jouy aux Arches where you can admire its famous roman aqueduct, then navigate the river until Novéant. The way back to the club will mostly take place on the emblematic river and end on Metz artificial lake which offers a surprising view of the city inside its green sanctuary. After lunchbreak you will go through Metz then take a return trip on Ars-sur-Moselle.



SIGHTSEEING

Centered around Metz city, this oneday tour stands as a 57km physical challenge, (as well as a wink at the department number). This tour also offers the less experienced rowers a 25km tour inside the main circuit, around Metz and its surroundings. Along the tormented route on the Moselle and its area, several canals offer many ponds and islands to discover on both routes: « Ile de Vaux », « Ile des Jésuites », « Ile St Symphorien », « Ile du Saulcy », « Ile Chambière », « Ile Fort Moselle », offer many natural places or inhabited areas sprinkled with architectural splendors to discover.
