
TOUR REIMS-CHAMPAGNE





ROUTE

This tour will take you between town and countryside, to the discovery of Champagne's capital. The route of the tour follows Reims green pathway, which is very popular among joggers and cyclists. It will take you sightseeing the most famous historical places of the coronation city. You will see St Rémi basilica which stands above the canal and shelters the relics of the Bishop who baptized Clovis, then the gothic cathedral and finally the conference center futurist liner. Afterwards city quickly gives way to nature, for you will travel along a green duck inhabited islet. You will keep on rowing among fields and woods to reach Courcy, a guiet farming town where many battles took place during the Great War. The route requires real navigation for it takes unexpected twists and turns, crosses lakes and is dotted with moored barges and fishermen. Companions may follow the tour by bike or else chose to spend the morning discovering the local UNESCO heritage sites.

SIGHTSEEING

Fancy a stroll along local vineyards ending with a taste of our local elixir? Why not a visit of the museum dedicated to the cathedral where the French Kings were crowned? What about some sport? You will have to choose! But you can also decide to visit other famous places such as the St Rémi basilica and museum, Notre-Dame Cathedral, the museum where German surrender on French soil was signed on May the 7th, 1945... There are also mustsees around the city, like the local vineyards, or numerous Great War tributes, as the "Fort de la Pompelle" museum, or the second battle of the Aisne site ("le chemin des Dames").
