

DRÔME ARDÈCHE TOUR

You will board on the Rhône river at the feet of Hermitage and Saint Joseph vineyards, near the famous rock at the centre of the river called "Table du Roy". Downstream you will pass by Tournon castle before reaching the cities of Tain l'Hermitage and Tournon sur Rhône, passing under one of the first French suspension bridge. The route will then take you to the Roche de Glun where the Rhône river widens before reaching the castle of Chateaubourg. After exiting the dead channel, you will have a clear view of Saint Appolinaire Cathedral and Crussol castle. You will disembark at Épervière harbour where you will enjoy a friendly barbecue. In addition to the historical monuments, you will be amazed by the natural beauty of the Rhône and its varied gastronomy : wines and local delicacies such as chocolate, goat cheese, pastries...
